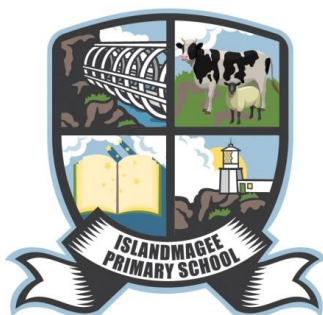

Christmas. Ref Covid-19 restrictions; time slots will be allocated to ensure

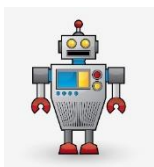
everyone's safety. Details to follow.
